## Winter Care Precautions

During extremely cold winters, where daytime temperatures are below zero for several days, it is wise to ensure that the tank is only about 2/3rd's full and the water supply turned off. This will prevent the frozen water from expanding and damaging the tank.



## 5. Tank-to-tank Connection

If you wish, you can connect two RainBowl Flower Water Butts together at the drain down point near the base of each tank. A 3P 3/4" Tank to Tank Connection Kit is ideal for this. Measure the distance between the threaded ports before ordering the required length of hose in the Connection Kit from your water butt supplier.

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## Instructions

To fill the Rainbowl Flower, we recommend using the 3P 3P Filter Collector with Push-Fit Connector Kit for Sealed Tanks to fill the rainwater tank. The Filter Collector is available in three colours: Black, Grey and Brown. (Code: 20008\*0ST).



Where the water butt cannot be located within 30cm of the downpipe, the longer Long Kits are available online (Art. No. 9000123ST to ST5).

The RainBowl Flower is delivered with an accessory kit which includes a chrome tap, wall bracket, and screws.

**If in any doubt during installation, please consult a professional tradesperson or the supplier of your filter or diverter.**





### 1. Setting up

Site the rain tank on a firm, level surface adjacent to a downpipe.

Read through these instructions and the 3P Filter Collector Instructions or other rain diverter instructions fully before proceeding.

This is a sealed tank so you cannot use a backnut to make a connection.

**If in any doubt during installation, please consult a professional tradesperson or the supplier of your filter or diverter.**

**Note about Diverters:** The recommended filter/diverter is the 3P Filter Collector with Push-Fit Connection for Sealed Tanks. Code 2000840ST.

If you have another diverter, please refer to the instructions for your selected downpipe filter.

### 2. For the 3P Filter Collector with Push-Fit Connection for Sealed Tanks

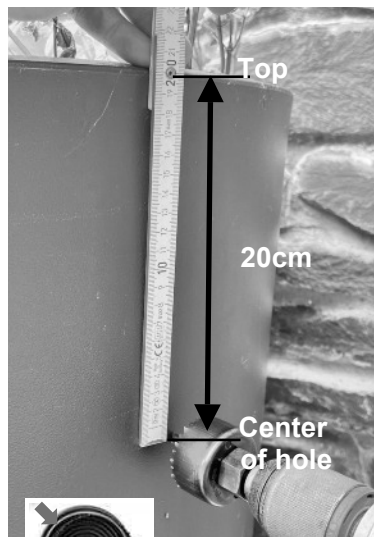
Locate the area to form a hole for connecting the downpipe filter or diverter.

The centre of the hole needs to be 20cm from the top of the Rainbowl Flower. This ensures rainwater will not flood the planting area.

Use the hole-saw set, taking care to select the correct saw size.

Choose the **44mm** holesaw. Double check sizes before drilling.

Insert the supplied grommet into the hole and ensure that a the inside of the grommet fits neatly onto the inside of the tank. **This is important** because the water tight seal is made on the inside of the tank.



### 2. Continued

Use a finger to feel the seal inside the tank and adjust the seal as required to ensure a good seal.

Push the Hose into the grommet (washing-up liquid or silicone grease will help ease this) and onto the outlet of the 3P Filter Collector.



**\* Top Tip!** Before filling with water, check the drain-down point is fully tightened. It may just need a ¼ turn. A 2p or 50p piece is the perfect tool if you don't have the right sized screwdriver. Don't over tighten.

### 3. Connecting the Tap

Screw the 3/4" brass tap provided in the Kit into the 3/4" BSP connection thread. If necessary, use PTFE tape when installing the tap to create a more watertight seal and to allow the tap to sit in the correct position \*.

### 4. Fixing the Wall Bracket

Fill the tank with water before attaching the wall bracket to avoid deflection. The bracket is optional.
